## Forthcoming Trade Missions

### Water Technology & Management, Cleantech, Innovation & Sustainability Trade Mission to Israel (Sunday 15 November - Saturday 21 November)

The Australia-Israel Chamber of Commerce will be leading a National Trade Mission to Israel in November 2009 focusing on Water Management, Water Technologies, and Sustainability (as well as other areas of interest to delegates, such as Cleantech and Agritech). The Mission will coincide with Israel's International Water Conference Watec 2009

### Our South Australian Group will be led by Dr Ian Chessell, Chief Scientist for South Australia.

The Trade Mission, specifically designed for CEO's and senior management from business, government and academia, will combine exposure to key Israeli industry figures together with topical high level business meetings designed to expose delegates to innovative business ideas and opportunities.



Key objectives of the mission include investigating Israeli expertise in:

- management of water resources,
- water reuse and water recycling,
- water desalination,
- water saving,
- alternative energies,
- waste management and technologies,
- cloud seeding,
- water security,
- river restoration and purification,
- agriculture under arid conditions,
- irrigation using effluent and saline water,
- clean technologies to ameliorate Climate Change
- updates on the latest Agritech products and solutions.

The mission will also examine Israeli government policy success in promoting R&D activities in a range of related fields. It will create an opportunity for Australian organisations participating to increase their exposure to the Israeli and international market and help promote Australian companies to a global audience in attendance at the Watec conference.

The mission is also a great opportunity for participants to network and interact with leading figures from the water industry within Australia. The Chamber will organise group and individual meetings with a cross section of Israeli business, academic and political leaders.

The Mission intends to include meetings with the following:

- **Ashkelon Desalination Plant** - Produces 100 million m<sup>3</sup> of desalinated water per year, making it the largest facility of its kind in the world
- **Better Place** - Transforming the automobile industry from petrol to 100% electric cars
- **Chief Scientist** office
- **IDE Technologies** - Pioneer and leader in delivery of sophisticated water solutions, working with state-of-the-art desalination technologies
- **Netafim** - World pioneer of drip irrigation
- **Shaf-Dan Sewage Plant** - Israel's largest waste-water plant
- **Solel** - World leader in design, manufacture and installation of solar fields for large scale power generation
- **Watec 2009** conference and exhibition
- **Weizmann Institute of Science** - An international centre of scientific research

The Chamber has been organising Trade Missions to Israel since 1989. Recent missions have been led by the Hon Warren Truss MP, then Minister for Agriculture, Forestry & Fisheries; NSW Premier the Hon Nathan Rees MP, then Minister for Water; Hugh Morgan AC, then President Business Council of Australia; and the Hon Evan Thornley MP, CEO Better Place, then Parliamentary Secretary to the Victorian Premier.

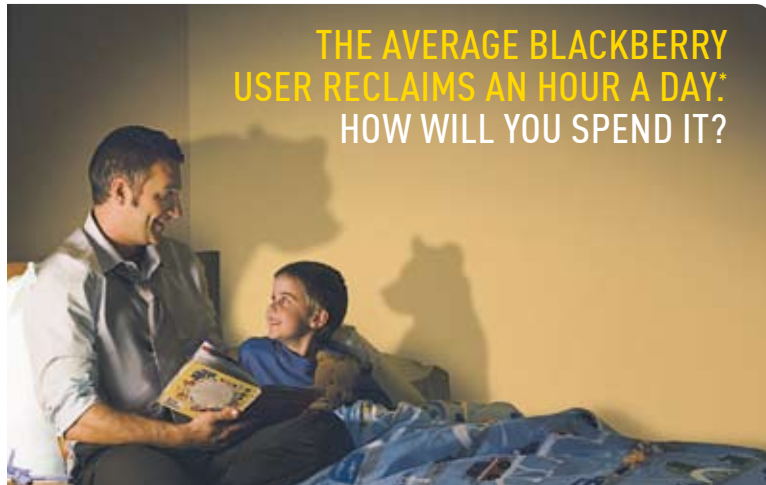
